Activity Sheet: Painting Stones

You will need:

Stones from anywhere (garden etc), smooth ones are best. If you have a certain design in mind, like a cat, or a caterpillar, lookout for the right shape stone. Acrylic Paint/left over decorating paints Acrylic paint pens, (look on Amazon for pens for using to decorate rocks).

Method;

- Clean the stone in soapy water.
- First, practice your design on a piece of paper.
- Use a pencil, chalk, or ultra fine Sharpie to draw your design on your stone.
- Now you're ready to paint! Move from the biggest parts of the design to the smallest, letting each coat dry before moving on.
- Once finished, leave overnight to dry. Seal your stone using a coat of PVA glue or clear nail varnish.
